- Puffiness around eyes

- Changes in urination

- Fatigue
- Itching

RISK FACTORS



HEALTH ISSUES

- Diabetes
- High blood pressure
- Cardiovascular disease
 - Kidney or ureter blockages
 - Obesity
 - Lupus



ETHNICITY

 African American, Hispanic, or Native American descent



LIFESTYLE

- Overuse of medications with ibuprofen, naproxen, or acetaminophen
 - Chronic use of illicit drugs



FAMILY HISTORY OR BACKGROUND

- Family history of kidney disease
 - Over 50
