**Supplies** Antimicrobial Soap or Alcohol based hand rub.

| <ol> <li>If gloves are worn, remove and discard in appropriate waste<br/>container. Exposes the skin for washing.</li> <li>Turn on warm running water.<br/>Note: Do not use basins or sinks filled with water. Repeated</li> </ol>                       |

| 3. Wet hands with running water. Water is needed to lather soap.   |
| 4. Apply soap to hands using amount recommended by the product manufacturer (frequently 3 to 5 ml). Soap will aid in breaking u and lifting contaminates away from the skin.   |
| 5. Rub hands together vigorously. Cover all surfaces of the hands<br>and fingers. Friction helps to remove skin surface contaminants.  |
| 6. Rinse hands with running water and dry thoroughly with a disposable towel. Washes contaminants off skin.  |
| <ul> <li>Turn off water faucet using a hands-free control or by touching<br/>the sink wrist blades with a clean single use paper towel.<br/>Avoiding direct contact with contaminated sink handle prevents<br/>contamination of washed hands.</li> </ul> |

|  | 3.<br>4.   | <ul> <li>Rub hands together covering all surfaces of the hands and fingers, until hands are dry.</li> <li>Allowing alcohol to dry completely allows adequate contact time to kill germs, allows alcohol to evaporate, and prevents risk of igniting flames due to alcohol's flammable properties.</li> <li>If after cleaning your hands with alcohol-based hand rub, you feel a buildup of emollients on your hands, it is recommended that you wash your hands with antimicrobial soap and water.</li> </ul> |  |  |  |  |  |  |  |
